Eurodoc is an international federation representing doctoral candidates and early-career researchers from over 30 countries in the European Union and the Council of Europe. Its main objectives are to represent these researchers at the European level in matters of education, research, and career development, to improve the quality of doctoral programs and research standards, and to promote cooperation and information exchange among national associations of young researchers across Europe

Main responsibilities include:

- interest in higher education politics in the European context
- preparation for and attendance of 5 (online) meetings organised by Eurodoc (European Council for Doctoral Candidates and Junior Researchers), including the GA
- responding to Eurodoc inquiries and contact with the Eurodoc board and the secretariat;
- monitoring and forwarding Eurodoc communication to the board and the member associations
- your first task as a eurodoc delegate could be to go from august 6th-9th to Copenhagen to the Eurodoc Conference and annual general meeting (with a financial participation from eurodoc)
